# Operation of AEN portal site

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### Operation of AEN portal site (utilization promotion of activity outcomes)

#### 5.1 Objective and overview

AEN that aimed at effective human upbringing in Asia, improvement of industrial competitive force and e-Learning business promotion, should not be closing but aggressively perform information transmission, and is aiming at cooperation with e-Learning related promotion body, etc. by attracting various people interest.

While e-Learning is internationally highlighting including Asia as an effective human upbringing technique, in order to promote genuine propagation expansion of the e-Learning in Asia in future, information share such as latest tendency and technical information opinion exchange and propagation enlightenment related to the e-Learning are mandatory. In order to aim at freely supplying all outcomes obtained by this AEN activity to world people, this portal site has been created.

In order that the AEN portal site is effectively functioning as information share location such as latest tendency and information related to the e-Learning between Asian countries, AEN portal site operation is being performed by updating the inserted information to latest site and by modifying the system that each function can be more comfortably used.

This year, we will improve the convenience for users by supplying Japanese site and by modifying multi-key, etc. of outcomes classification.

## 5.2 Utilization and promotion of SCORM viewer, SCORM assessor training content, etc.

Software and contents of the title which is outcomes of AEN was arranged to be able to freely access from the portal site.

#### (1) Supply of SCORM viewer

The SCORM viewer was developed in the OSS style as the learning system of standalone type of which e-Learning can be used even under insufficient environment of infrastructure maintenance required for internet such as internet, learning system, etc.

There are 2 items for this utilization effect as follows:

- Various SCORM compatible contents developed by other countries are used as the learning material, and technical improvement of own country can be done.
- e-Learning technologies of learning and improvement can be done by that SCORM technology and content case can be freely referred to.

#### (2) Supply of SCORM assessor training content

The SCORM assessor qualification system is the system that the SCROM complied content development engineers and the SCORM compatible content products defined by e-Learning Consortium, Japan, is to validate, and has been promoting introduction

to each AEN country and development.

As the link, there are "Understanding of system" and "Upbringing of SCORM engineer", and "SCORM assessor training content" that can be learned by e-Learning was developed as the learning material. This material has been prepared with 2 country languages of English and Japanese, and has been devised so as to easily understand by voice, exercise, etc.

This material is "Content presentation site" of the AEN portal, and anyone can learn using the ASP service at free of charge.

Therefore, each AEN country can efficiently learn the SCORM assessor system and SCORM technology using this content.

Furthermore, this material has been disclosed as text material other than supply by-Learning.

#### 5.3 Utilization promotion of AEN portal site

In order to improve the convenience of users for utilization promotion, the following 5 items were improved this year:

Supply of Japanese site:

There was only English site up to last year, and it was kept at a distance by general domestic users. This portal site was therefore arranged by 2 languages of English and Japanese so as to be freely accessed by the domestic users.

English translation of report document and disclosure:

The activity report was prepared by Japanese language up to last year, and was disclosed as it was, however since due to the language, it was difficult to use for various overseas country users, and the overview volume of report was translated into English to disclose the outcomes by both English and Japanese languages.

Opening of content presentation site:

Important and interested item for users regarding e-Learning is the content production. Typical content example was disclosed as hint of the content production, and in order to impress on user mind such as "It's amazing such method to create!!", this site was architected on LMS, and everyone could be used at free of charge.

Multi-key orientation of classification:

There was key only by year by year up to date for retrieving concerned outcomes, etc., however it was arranged for easy retrieval by adding the classified key by purpose/the key by country.

Screen renewal:

Present screen was reformed by synchronizing with multi-keys for easier understanding and easier menu/map.

#### 5.3.1 Supply of Japanese language site

• The following guidance mark to Japanese site was inserted into the AEN top page so that domestic users can also attract.




Figure 5-1 Link to Japanese site

• In order to let users understand AEN, the following index was inserted into cover page in Japanese site so as to be able answer on basic question of "What is doing?".




Figure 5-2 Activity overview introduction

#### 5.3.2 Registration of outcomes to English and Japanese site

#### (1) Registration of AEN report

Since the AEN various reports - 2004 were prepared by English and Japanese languages, these were processed to register both language sites. Access to this type of repot is very high, and in spite publication has not been specially performed, the number of download constantly exceeds 1000/month since registration start, and exceeds 5000 in total as of February 2006.

Popular reports are Japanese and English languages, and are as follows:

Japanese site:

Rank 1 report and rank 2 report are "Domestic trend surveillance" and "e-Learning trend surveillance in Asia respectively, and rank 3 is "Report searching for future image of e-Learning" titled "Report of high application committee of IT regarding "Knowledge"".

#### English site:

"e-Learning white paper" and "e-Learning trend survey report in Japan" are especially popular, following the report regarding "Quality criteria of content and e-Learning operation service". Deserving a special mention is the report of "e-Learning AWARD" which lowest ranking of Japanese language, however it is rank 4 here.

#### (2) Registration of SCORM assessor textbook

In order to acquire the assessor qualification to perform the SCORM validation, the short course textbook was simultaneously disclosed.

The textbook indexes are as follows:

- Chapter 1 SCORM assessor overview
- · Chapter 2 SCORM assessor system overview
- · Chapter 3 SCORM 1.2 overview
- Chapter 4 SCORM content creation method
- Chapter 5 SCORM content compatibility inspection method
- SCORM assessor terminology

The number of lump downloads of the whole volume are 70 Japanese textbooks and 120 English textbooks in the past 6 months.

Furthermore, each split chapter that can be downloaded is: the Japanese version is 350; "Chapter 4 SCORM content creation method" is approximately 100 in the past 6 months; "Chapter 3 SCORM 1.2 overview" is 80 which both is popular, and most interested descriptions are seemed to be "SCORM standard description" and "Standard complied content creation method".

Total number of download of English site reached 1000, following 170 for "Chapter 3 SCORM 1.2 overview" and 110 for both "Chapter 5 SCORM content complied inspection method" and "Chapter 4 Creating SCORM content".

#### (3) Other outcomes

As soon as SCORM viewer, SCORM 2004 guide/SCORM 2004 content creation guide and 2005 various reports were completed, these will be uploading on the portal site.

In addition, the content presentation site will be opened, and since typical content can be confirmed with e-Learning learning style with explanation, the easy handling portal site will be finishing for not only content developer but also for users.

#### 5.3.3 Multi-key orientation of classification and screen reform

The AEN portal site is disclosing so as to be able to download the AEN conference document and outcomes, however since the number of points exceeded 300, it became difficult to find the concerned document with present key by year base.




Figure 5-3 Former AEN top screen

Planning that various types of good content were to be observed with new idea of content presentation site (site that e-Learning can be actually experienced), was realized. (Japanese site/English site)

In order to architect this site, since LMS had to be actually operated, the function was supported with ASP.




Figure 5-7 Introduction screen of explanation document (initial screen)
